When will Holy Mass take place at Ss Peter & Paul? At the following times:

Saturday Vigil: 6pm, Sunday: 10am, Wednesdays: 9.30am , Fridays: 9.30am

During this time and until further notice Sunday Obligations remains suspended. Perhaps come to Mass during the week when numbers are lower.

Stewards will show you where to sit and also guide you as to when to go forward for Holy Communion.

There is no congregational singing, homilies are shorter and there are no bidding prayers. Responses are said but not in raised voices.

Some of the important regulations you are asked to follow:

- Holy Communion will be given in the hand only.
- Sanitise your hands with the alcohol gel as you enter and leave.
- Please wear a face covering while in the church.
- Make sure you keep the necessary two-meter distance at all times.
- Place your collection in the basket as you exit – or pay by PayPal.
